New Owners for Walla Walla Solar Farm

New owners have been announced for the proposed 300 megawatt (MW) Walla Walla Solar Farm, near Walla Walla.

FRV Services Australia (FRV) – a Sydney-based business and leader in Australia in the development of large scale solar farms across NSW, VIC, QLD and South Australia – have confirmed they will assume full ownership and development rights to the solar farm project.

FRV has stated:

“Walla Walla Solar Farm is in early stages of development and has potential to contribute both economically and environmentally to the region as well as the State.

“We are aware there has been significant contribution by neighbours and community members to date and appreciate the critical importance of maintaining engagement so that the community has full visibility of the project planning process.

“A priority for the Project Development team will also be to provide adequate opportunity for residents to put forward their issues and concerns and feel comfortable that FRV, as new owners, is committed to developing a reputable new business in the region.

Previous project owner, Bison Energy, initiated the development process for the solar farm in early 2018.
